

ITALIAN SOCIETY OF SURGERY <u>CALL for Proposal for papers - Second Edition</u>

Following the great success of the first edition in Rome, the Italian Society of Surgery is proud to launch the second edition of "proposal for papers".

These are original abstracts (i.e. previously unpublished data) that will be presented in two sessions: one reserved to junior authors (<=35 years) who must also be the first author in the abstract and the first author and the corresponding author in an original article to be submitted to Updates in Surgery, one for surgeons under 50 y.o.

The aim of this initiative is to promote research to be presented in a main meeting session and possibly published in Updates in Surgery.

Successful abstracts will be, therefore, presented in two dedicated sessions on September 18 and 19, 2023 during the 125th Congress of the Italian Society of Surgery in Pisa.

After the congress, the presenters are expected to write a manuscript according to journal's instructions

(https://www.springer.com/journal/13304/submission-guidelines).

A dedicated option (i.e. Proposal for papers 2023) will be open in the online submission system.

The deadline for abstracts to be considered for the "proposal for papers 2023" is May 31st 2023. Abstract must be submitted online (sic@sicitalia.org) (max word count: 250). Decision of acceptance/rejection will be notified by June

After the congress, deadline for submission of full-text manuscripts is January 31st 2024.

Please note that acceptance of an abstract for "proposal for papers" does not imply a commitment to publish a full text article in Updates in Surgery.

All manuscripts have to undergo peer review. However, the Editors strongly encourage young surgeons to join call for "proposal for papers 2023", and ensure their advice to make each selected abstract a successful manuscript in Updates in Surgery.

Accepted manuscripts will be published online as soon as accepted and will be cumulated in a special issue that will be delivered during the 2024 National Congress of SIC in Rome.
